### OVERVIEW:

Leading global operator specialised in the complete management of solar and wind assets for the generation of electricity is looking for a Project Manager.

This technical role is responsible for planning, coordinating, and managing all permitting and authorization activities required for the development and implementation of multiple PV and BESS projects in Germany.

The Project Manager will lead the preparation and management of all documentation needed to obtain building permits, environmental authorizations, and other relevant approvals, including easements, licenses, consents, and minor permits.

The role ensures that all permitting procedures comply with German legislation, FRV's internal ESG standards, and, where applicable, lender requirements.

### RESPONSIBILITIES:

As part of the Project Development team, this position will be accountable for supporting the different stages of project development, including:

- Conduct early-stage project screening, initial assessments, and due diligence investigations.
- Identify permitting and development risks and proactively inform the Origination and Development teams throughout all project phases.
- Lead and coordinate environmental, geotechnical, and other studies required under German law and in line with industry best practices.
- Engage with relevant stakeholders and manage land-use rights, including site control, easements, servitudes, and wayleaves.
- Manage external consultants and service providers, ensuring deliverables meet terms of reference, legislative requirements, and internal standards, while being delivered on time and within budget.
- Critically review reports, studies, and data received from specialists, engineers, and advisors to ensure compliance with German legislation and FRV internal guidelines.
- Collaborate with external legal counsel to prepare responses, statements, and appeals when required.
- Act as a key point of contact for internal and external stakeholders, including development partners, environmental working groups, conservation agencies, local municipalities, lenders, and government authorities.
- Represent the project at public meetings when required, including presentations and responding to stakeholder questions.
